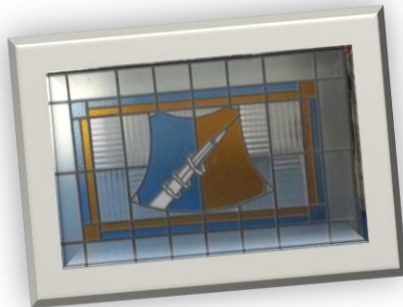

It is open Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays, from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

Entry to the Museum is free.

The Museum provides a permanent home for our ever growing collection of Rayleigh related artefacts. There is a lecture theatre for regular talks and slide shows, educational and research facilities, books, photographs, maps, children's activities and much more.

Exhibitions will be rotated and temporary special exhibitions arranged.

The Museum is an independent registered charity. Rayleigh Town Council supports the Museum and makes a contribution towards its costs.
